MINE OPERATIONS UNAFFECTED BY EARTHQUAKE

Vancouver, British Columbia, August 16, 2007 - Gold Hawk Resources Inc. ("Gold Hawk" or the "Company") (TSX-V: CGK) wishes to advise that the earthquake and after shocks that hit Peru's coast Wednesday evening resulted in no accidents or injuries and had no significant impact on the mine and mill, at the Company's Coricancha Mine in Peru.

The Company has completed inspections of the mine's underground workings and plant infrastructure and reports no damage to the operations, or to the local infrastructure surrounding the mine. The mine and mill continue to operate normally.

The Company offers its sympathy and condolences to those affected by the earthquake.
